




Animal Control and Wildlife 2378 Animal Control calls 666 wildlife assisted

Although they are thriving, their late birth means they won't survive the harsh Wisconsin winter on their own. We will be caring for them over the winter and release this family of goofballs in the spring. We are also hoping to add one of these critters to our education program!
