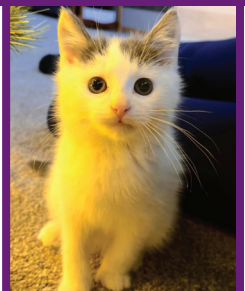

In 2023, **CRHS** spent
\$142,435.38 in medical services and **\$62,054.00** in medical supplies.

Additionally, \$35,293.92 was donated in medical services and \$7,000 donated in supplies.

In late September we had 2 groups of opossums were brought to us. Both mothers were hit by car and tragically died. The two groups were put together and instantly became a big, happy family. After 2 weeks of syringe feeding, they were able to eat on their own.

Although they are thriving, their late birth means they won't survive the harsh Wisconsin winter on their own. We will be caring for them over the winter and release this family of goofballs in the spring. We are also hoping to add one of these critters to our education program!
