

Puppy Kindergarten \$75.00

8 weeks – 4 months

This course focuses on puppy socialization. Puppy Socialization is exposure to different stimuli in a positive or neutral way in order to develop well-rounded adult dogs. The class will also lay the foundation for your new, growing, puppy through positive communication and training. Cues learned in this course will include “Come”, “Sit”, “Down”, and “Stand”. Beginning stages of stay will also be introduced. Puppy play time will be included in class sessions.

This class is 60-minutes in length and is held once a week for 7 weeks.

Puppy II \$75.00

4 months – 6 months

This course is for puppies who have completed Puppy Kindergarten. This class focuses on proofing basic cues (“Come”, “Sit”, “Down”, and “Stand”) which were taught in Puppy Kindergarten. We will work to solidify the recall (coming when called) as your adolescent dog begins to test their boundaries. We will add cues such as “Leave It”, “Wait”, and “Stay”, while adding a release. Socialization and exposure to various stimuli will continue during sessions in this class.

This class is 60-minutes in length and is held once a week for 7 weeks.

Beginner Basics \$75.00

6 months +

This course is for older puppies and adolescent dogs who have not completed a prior training class. This course focuses on basic training and will lay the foundation for dogs (and pet parents) in order to establish a lifetime bond through positive training. This class will cover how dogs learn in order for pet parents to communicate cues such as “Come”, “Sit”, “Down”, “Stand”, “Wait”, “Leave It”, and “Stay” clearly and effectively. Topics discussed include jumping, counter surfing, barking, and digging. Socialization will be incorporated through exposure to sights, sounds, and experiences to stimuli in a way that is positive, or neutral.

This class is 60-minutes in length and is held once a week for 7 weeks.

Intermediate Training \$75.00

Dogs that have completed Puppy II, Beginner Basics, OR by Dog Trainer Approval Only

This course builds on behaviors and cues worked on in prior training courses. Tasks in this class become more challenging for dogs (and pet parents) as we begin to increase the “3-D’s”. Loose leash walking will continue to be worked on, and “Heel” will also be taught at this level in training. Socialization through desensitization of stimuli that are presented in a positive and neutral way is incorporated throughout class sessions.

This class is 60-minutes in length and is held once a week for 7 weeks.

Advanced Training \$75.00

Dogs that have completed Intermediate Training, OR by Dog Trainer Approval Only

This course improves on behaviors learned. Our goal is to have dogs who listen to our cues (i.e. a dog that comes when called) no matter the situation. This course works on increasing duration, building distance, and intensifying distractions in order to achieve cue consistency. Through continued practice, and repetition, your dog will gain the skills needed to be successful in everyday situations and challenges.

This class is 60-minutes in length and is held once a week for 7 weeks.

AKC Canine Good Citizen Class* \$84.00

11 months +

This class is your comprehensive guide as training tips during class, and take home practice after class, prepare you and your canine for the AKC Canine Good Citizen Evaluation. This course is seven weeks in length and includes the evaluation to be conducted on the seventh, and final, class session. Each week specific testing items, for a total of 10 items, will be reviewed and practiced.

This class is 60-minutes in length and is held once a week for 7 weeks. The cost for the test/evaluation is included in the class registration fee, for your convenience. Prior formal training is a prerequisite to participate in this course.

****Dogs must have an AKC, PAL, or AKC Canine Partners number to earn an official title. All dogs can get a number including purebreds and mixed breeds. Official title is not required to earn a certificate.***

Beginner Agility* \$75.00

10 months +

Dogs that have completed at least one prior training course, OR by Dog Trainer Approval Only

Canine Agility is a sport that has grown in popularity internationally over the years. The Beginner Agility class is an interactive class designed for pet parents who are interested in building communication with their canine companion through this sport; or who would simply enjoy a class that is challenging, exciting, positive, and most importantly FUN! This class focuses on not only communication, but also the *foundations* required to get your canine started off on the right paw in this fast-paced, exciting sport. We will work together on body awareness & fitness, along with familiarizing your dog to obstacles in a safe and positive environment. The Beginner Agility Course is designed for fundamentals, not speed.

This class is 60-minutes in length and is held once a week for 7 weeks. Prior formal training is a prerequisite to participate in this course.

**This course is seasonal and will be held outdoors pending weather conditions. On days when there is adverse weather, class will be held indoors. Due to space limitations, one handler per dog is permitted during indoor sessions.*

Intermediate Agility* \$75.00

12 months +

Dogs that have completed at least one prior training course & Beginner Agility, OR by Dog Trainer Approval Only

The Intermediate Agility Course is the continuation of our Beginner Agility Course designed for pet parents who are interested in building their communication with their canine companion through this fast paced, ever growing, canine sport. As you maneuver through obstacles your canine looks & listens to your cues for direction. In this class we will continue to focus on the fundamentals as we begin to increase cue consistency and distance with our dogs. Work on agility course obstacles such as the weave poles & sea-saw will be practiced to increase fluidity. Fitness & stretching will be reviewed to keep your canine happy, healthy, and safe through the course.

This class is 60-minutes in length and is held once a week for 7 weeks. Prior formal training and Beginner Agility is a prerequisite to participate in this course.

**This course is seasonal and will be held outdoors pending weather conditions. On days when there is adverse weather, class will be held indoors. Due to space limitations, one handler per dog is permitted during indoor sessions.*

Consultations \$35.00

This 50-60 minute consultation with our Dog Trainer covers your dog's specific training needs for behavioral assessment, class placement, and/or private sessions. Expert advice is provided on a course of action for your canine companion. *Consults are not training sessions.*

1 Hour Private Session \$60.00

One-on-One training session with the Dog Trainer working on your dog's specific training goals and/or behavioral issues.

(3) 1-Hour Private Session \$150.00

Three separate hours of One-on-One training sessions with the Dog Trainer working on your dog's specific training goals and/or behavioral issues. These hours can be scheduled in advance, or on an as needed basis.
